Sunday 23 April, 1100 - 1300 - National Coastwatch Institution, Herne Bay. Station Manager Paul Waterman will explain the role of the NCI, a voluntary organisation which provides the eyes and ears along the coast, monitoring radio channels and providing a listening watch in poor visibility. Duration - 1-2 hours. COST: Free. NOTE: Maximum 15 people.
